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At Annaghmakerrig we provide two different types of accommodation: The Big House, where food is provided and residents help themselves to breakfast and lunch, and where the only requirement as dictated by Tyrone Guthrie's Will is that all meet at 7.00 p.m. for dinner prepared by our renowned chefs. The main meal of the day on Sundays and Bank Holidays is at 1.30. In The Big House, if alerted in advance, we cater for vegetarians; however we have a small staff and are unable to provide separate meals for vegans. The second type of accommodation is self-catering in the Farmyard Cottages, with however one dinner a week in The Big House with prior arrangement with the chefs. The Centre has Broadband Internet, printing and faxing facilities. There is also a well-equipped laundry space available for all residents. We have one specially fitted cottage for artists with disabilities that has a room for a companion. We also provide a motorized buggy to enable access to the grounds to those normally wheel-chair bound or infirm. In order to make your stay as comfortable as possible we ask that you alert us to any special needs you may have.

Your application will be acknowledged shortly after receipt, and your application will be processed in as timely a fashion as possible. However, it is important to be aware that there is a considerable volume of applications and this may result in a delay of several weeks. The decision is reached by Selection Panel drawn from the Board which includes experienced arts practitioners, together with the Chair of the Board and the Director. The panel's decision is final. However, an initial rejection does not mean that a repeat application will not be considered in the future. Once you have been accepted you should contact the Centre to discuss a mutually suitable date for your residency. There is a huge demand for rooms, especially during the summer and holiday periods, so it is important to plan ahead to avoid disappointment.

Once your residency dates have been agreed we require a non-refundable deposit in order to guarantee your booking.
